DryPlan Terms & Conditions

Exclusively for Eyeplan Members

DryPlan is a Specialist Eye Health Care scheme requiring a 'top-up' fee which covers your Specialist Dry Eye appointments (assessments and aftercare as required), and the supply of appropriate therapeutic product for the ongoing treatment of Blepharitis, Meibomian Gland Disfunction, evaporative dry eye and other related eye conditions.

If you are a registered Eyeplan Member (ask a member of our team for more details, or <u>Click Here</u>) and have been advised that you need on-going <u>Specialist Dry Eye Management</u>, then DryPlan is for you.

For a small additional monthly payment DryPlan gives you:

- Regular Dry Eye assessment and management appointments with your Specialist Optometrist
- Clinically recommended supplementary treatments (such as Blephex and Blephasteam) as frequently as your Optometrist recommends
- Regular supplies of Eyelid Care products to improve and maintain the health of your eyes
- A printed report to show your initial diagnostic assessment result, and regular updates to monitor the progress of your treatment

DryPlan is a 'top-up' to a standard Eyeplan registration. DryPlan is not available to you if you are not a standard Eyeplan member. When you join DryPlan you are committing to a minimum of 12 months payments. The supply of Eyelid Care products is regulated and controlled by your Specialist Optometrist. DryPlan is not transferrable to another Optical practice. Your statutory rights are not affected.
